Draft Laois PPN Workplan 2021

Dan advised the Secretariat that Laois PPN are required by the Department to have approved Workplan, Budget and MOU in place to secure funding for Laois PPN. Paddy Buggy complimented Dan Bergin on the preparation of the Draft Workplan 2021, Draft Budget 2021 and MOU.

Draft Laois PPN Budget 2021

The Draft Laois PPN Budget 2021 had been circulated to the Members of the Secretariat prior to the Monthly Meeting. Dan gave the Secretariat Members an update on the Draft

Budget. The Draft Budget has taken into account the Financial Controls Document issued by the Dept. in quarter 4 of 2020. This Financial Controls Document has been circulated to the Secretariat.

County Plenary

The 1st County Plenary is scheduled for Tuesday 4th March at 7pm via Microsoft Teams rather than 25th February. This will allow time to promote the Plenary. As a positive gesture to PPN Member Groups, to advertise and promote the County Plenary and support local business in Laois there will be a raffle for 3 x €50 Laois Gift Cards for attendees on the night.

Calendar of Meetings

The Secretariat agreed that the Monthly Meeting of the Laois PPN Secretariat would take place on the 3rd Tuesday of each month (except August) for 2021.

Dan advised the Secretariat that the Dept have expressed an interest to attend a Monthly Secretariat Meeting across the 31 PPN's to observe and better understand the day to day workings of the PPN. The Secretariat Members welcomed the opportunity to show the Department the volume and variety of work achieved by Laois PPN.

Funding Opportunities

Laois PPN recognises the challenging year it has been for Community Groups in relation to fundraising. So many Community Groups have traditionally relied on club lotto, raffles, fund raising days, bag packing and local events to raise money and many of these routes have been taken away. With this in mind, Laois PPN have been providing regular updates on potential fundraising opportunities through grants and funds as they become available. Laois PPN Member Groups have welcomed the info and opportunity to apply.

To assist Member Groups Laois PPN will be running a Grant Writing Tips & Tricks Workshop in March.

Donal O'Shea welcomed the funding opportunities being circulated by Laois PPN. He informed the Meeting that he would like the Government to provide more funding opportunities to Social Inclusion Groups in the future.

MRPPN April Meeting - Laois PPN Agenda Item "Rebuilding"

The next Meeting of MRPPN is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 21st April. The Laois PPN item will be "Rebuilding" which had been put forward by Paddy Buggy and agreed by the Secretariat. Paddy informed the meeting that "Rebuilding" could explore how we rebuild here in Laois. The "Rebuilding" theme was discussed by the Members of the Secretariat. Laois PPN will host and Chair the MRPPN Meeting on Wednesday 21st April.

LCDC Election

Naeem Iqbal has been elected as the Laois PPN Social Inclusion Rep to the LCDC. This is to be ratified at the Council Meeting on Monday 22nd February.

Paddy Buggy congratulated Naeem on his successful election and wished him well in his role as Laois PPN Social Inclusion Rep to the LCDC. The other Members of the Secretariat echoed this sentiment.

Dan informed the Secretariat that this had been Laois PPN's first ever online election and that online election had worked successfully in filling the vacancy. This was welcomed by Members of the Secretariat.
